18-Feb	1823	Elizabeth	Hewetson	<i>died at R'dale Town, on 18 feb 1823. Grocer. Interred at MH burial ground</i>
18-Jun	1823	Bridget	Hewetson	<i>died on 18 june 1823 at Clay Lands, aged 52, wife of Robert Hewetson. Interred in MH burying ground</i>
08-May	1823	Margaret	Knewstubb	<i>died at Greenside on 8 May 1823. Interred in the MH burying ground.</i>
07-Jan	1823	Fanny	Richardson	<i>died at Lockholm on 7 jan 1823, a poor lunatic. Interred in MH burial ground</i>
16-Apr	1824	Mary	Hewetson	<i>of the Town, died 12 apr 1824, buried in the MH burying ground</i>
10-Jun	1824	Ann	Rennison	<i>wife of John Rennison of the Town, died on 8 jun, interred in the MH burying ground.</i>
30-Apr	1825	Mary	Hewetson	<i>widow of John Hewetson of Crooksbeck, died 26 apr 1825 aged 67 yrs. Interred in the MH burying ground</i>
26-May	1830	Henry	Hewetson	<i>of Kendal, buried in R'dale MH burial ground</i>
29-Jan	1830	Elizabeth	Hill	<i>wid of the Rev John Hill, late Minister of R'dale, died at R'dale 26 jan 1830, buried in the MH burial ground</i>
13-May	1832	Benjamin	Hewetson	<i>of Kendal, died at Kendal on 9 May and was buried in the R'dale MH burying ground</i>

12-Mar	1833	<b>John</b>	<b>Beck</b>	<i>of Dubbs, one of the Trustees of the MH, died 8 mar 1833 after a long and painful illness. Interred in the burying ground</i>
02-Apr	1833	<b>Isabella</b>	<b>Guy</b>	<i>widow of the late John Guy, carrier to Kendal, died 30 mar 1833 .... "She had long been a mother in Israel"</i>
15-Nov	1833	<b>Ruth</b>	<b>Hewetson</b>	<i>wife of Ewbank Hewetson of Cold Beck, died in child-bed and her stillborn infant who had been buried two weeks before was disinterred for the purpose of being buried with its parent in the same grave as its "amiable but unfortunate mother"</i>
