1610-1623		Thomas Fothergill	born at Brownber, Ravenstonedale, W'land. Entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1614; BA 1617, MA 1620, BD 1627, elected a Fellow of the College in 1618, became Tutor and President of the College. He was College Tutor to John Barwick, who out of gratitude procured him a Prebendal Stall in York Cathedral on Charles II's Restoration. Died c.1675. He left £40 to Sedbergh School, £300 to St John's College and £100 to St Paul's.
1623-1630		George Fothergill	B. W'land; entered St Johns Coll, Cambridge in 1625; BA 1628, MA 1631. He was probably Vicar of Orton, W'land c1643, after some difficulty with the Bishop who at first refused to institute him. In 1662 he was ejected for not complying with the Act of Uniformity, but afterwards conformed, and became Vicar of Worksop, Notts. He gave £10 towards the building of the third court at St John's, in 1669.
1673		Anthony Procter	Curate of Ravenstonedale - and initiated the practice of ringing the Church bell at the conclusion of the Nicene Creed to call in Dissenters to the Sermon
1670-1680	1659	Hugh SHAW	son of Robert Shaw of Ravenstonedale - entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1677, age 18
1680-1690	1664	Miles HODGSON	son of Rowland Hodgson of Dent, Entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1682 age 18, BA 1685, MA 1693, Master of Ravenstonedale Grammar School 1688-1690
1680-1690	1681	Marmaduke HOLME	son of John Holme of Sedbergh, Entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1700 age 19; BA 1703 (as Holmes), Master of Ravenstonedale Grammar School 1703-1707. Vicar of Cliburn, W'nd 1739. died in 1760
1700-1708	1674	Robert SHAW	son of William Shaw of Ravenstonedale. Entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1696 age 22; BA 1699. Master of Ravenstonedale Grammar School 1700-1702
1709-1720	1693	Matthew SCARBROUGH	son of Matthew Scarbrough of Hill, Ravenstonedale. Entered St John's Col. Cambridge in 1713, age 20, BA 1716
1720-1730	1709	Edward HOLMES	son of John Holmes, of Sedbergh. Entered St John's Coll. Cambridge in 1722, age 19; BA 1725, MA 1729. Master of Ravenstonedale Grammar School 1726-1728. Perhaps Vicar of Birling Kent, 1757
1746-1760	1732	Anthony FOTHERGILL	son of Anthony Fothergill, chr at Ravenstonedale 12 mar 1732. After leaving Sedbergh, he studied at Edinburgh where he became MD in 1763. He was abroad fo a time, then began practice at Northampton and was successful. He became FRS in 1778. In 1780 he removed to the London House before occupied by Dr John Fothergill, an intimate friend, but not a relation. He did not prosper here and went in 1784 to Bath, where he gained a very extensive practice. He retired to Philadelphia in 1803, where he seems to have intended to pass the rest of his life, but returned to England in 1812 and died 11 may 1813. He left large legacies to various public institutions. As a doctor, he is best known for his Essay on the Methods of Restoring Persons Apparently Drowned, for which he received in 1794 a gold medal from the Royal Humane Society. Like his namesake, he was a great philanthropist, and much interested in Literature and science.
1854	1842	Edward Parr METCALFE	Entered August age 12 born Ravenstonedale, left October 1861. Head of School, Sixth Form and Math. Prizes; scholar of Christ's Coll. Cambridge, BA, Thirtieth Wrangler and Second Class, Classical Tripos 1865, MA 1868, Second Class, Theological Tripos 1866. Madras Educational Department, HEad of Rajahmundry School, and acting Inspector of Schools, Nov 1872-1877; Fellow of Madraw University, Mar 1880; Principal of Rajahmundry College, Oct 1877. Now retired. Present address Uplands, Belvedere Road, Upper Norwood, SE (London)
1856	1843	William FOTHERGILL	entered Feb age 14, born 17 jan 1843 at Wath, Ravenstonedale; date of leaving uncertain. Became a Farmer. Died 20 jul 1890.
1858	1848	Robert Weston METCALFE	brother of E P Metalfe (Entrance 1854) entered April, age 11, born 23 nov 1848 at Ashfield Ravenstonedale, left Dec 1868. First Eleven, St Johns Coll Cambridge, BA, Jun.Opt. 1873, MA 1877, Senior Asst Master of Richmond School, Yorks 1879-1880. Principal of the Collegiate School Ootacamund, India 1880-1884, Her Majesty's Chaplain of Hyderabad Assigned Districts 1885-1888, Examiner in Univerity of Madras and Uncovenanted Civil Service 1881-1885, Vicar of Ravenstonedale 1888. Editor of Ravenstonedale Parish Registers (three volumes). Died Sep 7, 1908.
1900	1888	Anthony METCALFE-GIBSON	(Mr Mackie and Mr Martyn), son of A Metcalfe Gibson Esq, Ravenstonedale; entered September, born Nov 26 1888, left Jul 1906. Prefect, Pembroke Coll, Cambridge, Present Address Pembroke College, Cambridge or Coldbeck, Ravenstonedale.
1906	1891	Thomas Hewetson BECK	(Mr Martyn), son of G M Beck, Esq, Ravenstonedale, entered Jan, born Jan 11 1892, left april 1908. Present address, The Lane, Ravenstonedale, W'land
